AB 06-107 Ordinance 814 Zoning Regulation Adoption

Robert Strope, City Administrator, presented AB 06-107 explaining the City Council has conducted and closed the public hearing on the proposed revisions at the August 16, 2006 City Council regular meeting and directed the staff to submit the zoning regulation to the State Agencies for review. The required 60 day review period has expired and the City can now adopt the revised zoning ordinance. **C. Phillips made the motion to approve AB 06-107 with C. Ahern seconding the motion. 5 Ayes 0 Nays, motion passed.**
