

Long Beach City Hall

115 Bolstad Ave. E.

In May 1914, The Ladies Union Aid Society of Long Beach erected a building which sat on a lot they leased from Henry Tinker for one dollar a year. In June of that year the U.S. Post Office moved into that building and paid \$50 a year for rent. This building was located near where the Long Beach Pharmacy now stands and patrons rode up to the post office on horseback and tied their horses to trees in the area.

The town of Long Beach was platted in 1922 and because the Ladies Aid building site did not conform to any of the new lots it was moved farther north and west to accommodate the platting where it still stands today. In 1947, this building was donated to the Town of Long Beach by the Ladies Union Aid Society and would become "City Hall". The post office continued to share the building with the city and it stayed in that building for over 45 years. In November 1959 a new post office was erected on the northwest corner of Oregon and First St. (Bolstad) and the Post Office moved out of "City Hall" for the first time since 1914.
