

Ordinance NO. 825

An ordinance of the City of Long Beach, Washington to amend and repeal portion of City of Long Beach Code, Chapter 9, Section 3-0-3, repeal Sub-section A and establishing a new fee structure for the rental of the trolley for public use and amending Sub-section B.

Whereas, there is a need within the community for transportation designed for special events and occasions, and

Whereas, the City of Long Beach has a trolley available for use at such events and occasions, and

Whereas, the City of Long Beach desires to make the trolley available for such events and occasions,

Now THEREFORE, be it ordained by the city council of the City of Long Beach, Washington, as follows:

Section 1. Repeal Subsection A in its entirety and replacing it with the following:

~~SECTION 1. RENTAL RATES AND INSURANCE~~

~~Rental for use within the City of Long Beach by not for profit groups and organizations deemed to provide a public benefit:~~

~~\$35 per hour with a two hour minimum plus \$2.00 per mile. This fee includes a driver.~~

~~\$50 per day plus \$2.00 per mile. This fee does not include a driver, the user must provide a driver that possesses a Commercial Drivers License that allows for operation of vehicles to carry passengers.~~

~~Rental for use outside the City of Long Beach by not for profit groups and organizations deemed to provide a public benefit:~~

~~\$70 per hour with a two hour minimum plus \$2.00 per mile. This fee includes a driver.~~

~~\$100 per day plus \$2.00 per mile. This fee does not include a driver, the user must provide a driver that possesses a Commercial Drivers License that allows for operation of vehicles to carry passengers.~~

~~Users must provide the City proof of insurance that lists the City of Long Beach as an additional insured party for \$1,000,000.~~

~~These rates shall take effect immediately~~

Sub-section A. Rental rates for Long Beach Trolley.

Rental for use within the City of Long Beach by groups and organizations deemed to provide a public benefit:

Forty-Five dollars (\$45.00) per hour with a two hour minimum plus \$2.00 per mile. This fee includes a driver.

Three-hundred dollars (\$300.00) per day (eight {8}hours to twelve {12}hours is one day rental) plus \$1.50 per mile. This fee includes a driver.

Rental for use outside the City of Long Beach by groups and organizations deemed to provide a public benefit:

Seventy-five dollars (\$75) per hour with a two hour minimum plus \$2.00 per mile. This fee includes a driver.

Three-hundred and fifty dollars (\$350.00) a day (eight {8}hours to twelve {12}hours is one day rental) plus \$1.75 per mile. This fee includes a driver.

These rates shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect unless changes by Resolution of the Long Beach City Council.

Section 2. Amend Sub-section B to read:

Sub-section B. Uses.

Use of the Trolley:

The general use of the trolley shall be limited to for functions and events for the City of Long Beach, or functions and events sponsored by groups or organizations that provide a public benefit.

Extended use by private individuals, groups or other users will be approved by the City Administrator on a case by case basis and will require to sign a hold harmless and contract with the city to include a no alcohol use on the trolley.

Section 3. Sub-section C Advertising will remain the same.

The City shall permit advertising on and in the Trolley for businesses located within the corporate boundaries of the City of Long Beach as follows:

The advertising shall be on a first come, first served basis.

The cost of all advertising design, copy, production, installation, and removal shall be paid by the advertiser.

The fee shall be \$50 per year for one space of interior advertising up to 11 by 17 inches.

The fee for exterior advertising shall be \$350 per year for advertising on the rear of the Trolley.

The Lodging Tax Advisory Committee shall review and approve all advertising prior to placement on the Trolley.

These rates shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect unless changed by Resolution of the Long Beach City Council.

Section 4. Effective Date

Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after the date of publication.

Section 5. Adoption Date
