Dear Mrs. Price:

I have finished working on the last three requests, numbered three through five of your original five requests from July 21, 2014. Here what you have requested (in italics) and what I have found:

Request 3 of 5 Appears to request *all documents regarding Dick Reiners and the Project Mr. Ostrem developed on 19th NW, including Army Corp of Engineers. You also want anything the city has related to Mr. Reiners and the Price Family.* I have included all correspondence with Mr. Reiners, regardless of whom he was corresponding with.

Request 4 of 5 requests the city provide *all documentation regarding the Price Family Members involvement with Shoerview Estates Development and Leroy Ostrem. I don't understand the sentence that says "Any involvement with City Council meetings David Glasson"* I was unable to find any mention of the Price Family in any documentation other than the initial notice that was on the mailing list for item #1. I am still looking for clarification on "Any involvement with City Council meetings David Glasson" as it could be overly broad as I attend almost every council meeting and have involvement in almost all of them over the last 24 years.

Request 5 of 5 requests the city provide *all documentation regarding William Mintelius (spelling) Price involvement with Dick Reiners, Leroy Ostrem of Shoreview Estates and the City of Long Beach regarding the construction of 19th NW ownership of the property that 19th NW is on Transfer of the City of Long Beach ownership of the road 19 NW to Leroy Ostrem Provide anything he signed. I am reading that to mean you would like any documentation of Mr. William Price and Dick Reiners and Leroy Ostrem that city has on file.* I was unable to find anything related to William Minteuus Price in the cities files.

There are 71 pages in request #3. At fifteen cents per page, this comes to \$10.65. Ad this to the \$16.96 from my first response for the first two request, I have a total of \$27.60 I will process the check #2157 for \$50.00 today and refund you the difference of \$22.40 and send that as a check to you tomorrow. In the first request I answered requests one and two, so this should complete this request, other than the clarification needed in request 4 above.
