### BUSINESS

#### **AB 20-56– RZ 2020-01 Oman Rezone Application PUBLIC HEARING (withdrawn)**

David Glasson, City Administrator, presented the Agenda Bill. Steve Oman applied for a rezone of block 86 of Tinker's 2<sup>nd</sup> South Addition to Long Beach to reclassified from R3 – Multi-Family Residential to R2R – Two-Family Residential Restricted. The Planning Commission heard this application and recommended that it not be approved by City Council. Since that time, the applicant has withdrawn the application but code section 12-3-3(F) states that: F. Withdrawal and Renewal: The planning commission or city council, as appropriate, may permit the withdrawal of any application filed under the provisions of this title; provided, that any hearing must be held for which notice has been given. An application that has been previously withdrawn shall not be scheduled for reconsideration unless a new application has been submitted and a fee paid as required by subsection B of this section.

Therefore, the City Council must hold a public hearing as advertised.

**AB 20-57– RCO Resolution 20-08 Approving Boardwalk Reconstruction Application**

**C. Svendsen moved to Approve Resolution 2020-08 authorizing the receipt of RCO grant funds for the purpose of reconstructing the Boardwalk. C. Cline seconded the motion; 4 Ayes; 1 absent (C. McGuire), motion passed.**
