BUSINESS

AB 24-14 – G&O Contract Amendment for Lift Station Design and Construction Management

Ariel Smith, Community Development Director, presented the agenda bill. This contract authorizes Gray and Osborne to bill for design and construction management related to reconstruction of three pump stations. This project is 100% grant funded through a congressional spending award, managed by the EPA.

C. Coleman made the motion to authorize Mayor Svendsen to sign the agreement with G&O for design and management services. C. Perez seconded the motion; 5 Ayes, motion passed.

AB 24-15 – Ordinance 1032 – FOG (Fats, Oils, & Grease) Regulations and Inspections

Ariel Smith, Community Development Director, presented the agenda bill. Fats, Oils, and Grease can be extremely harmful to the city's wastewater collection system and ultimately, the treatment plant. This ordinance outlines the requirement of inspections for qualifying businesses. Software was purchased to ensure proper record keeping; Erik will be conducting the inspections and maintaining records.

No decisions or motions were made at this time. The council discussed scheduling a workshop.
