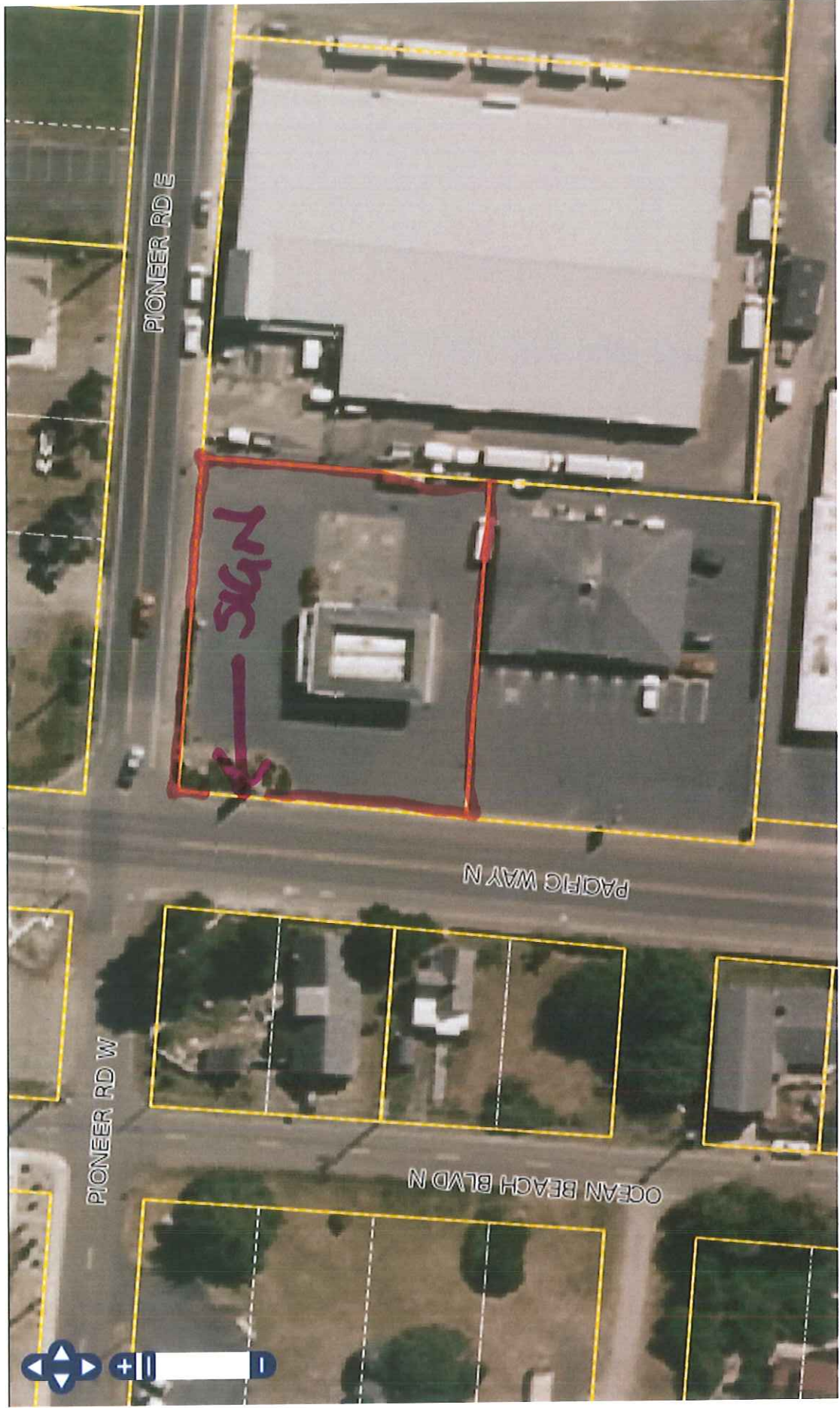

SUMMARY STATEMENT: The Pioneer Chevron has been discussing modifications to their existing signage with staff for a while. The property is located in the C1-Commercial zone and is allowed 1 freestanding sign up to 50 square feet. It is allowed internally lit at a ratio of 2:1 on the square footage allocation. Staff estimates the current free-standing sign is at least 50 square feet. Because all non-conforming signs will sunset at the end of 2015, the Chevron would like to make a good investment that won't need removal or reconfiguring in a year. Their sign designer will be present to discuss possible changes to the sign and to discuss the unique issues associate with the retail gas business.

Staff would like to hear from Council their thoughts on this situation and is prepared to describe the avenues that Chevron has or may have in the future to permit a sign that is "right for the site".

Rod Run Weekend, September 5th – 7th, went well. I brought down 25 extra officers for the weekend. The crowds were large and well behaved. We issued 42 citations over the course of the weekend. That was up from last year when we only issued 12. Even though the number of citations was higher I still am pleased with the way the crowds behaved. For some reason this year we had a very high number of suspended drivers down for the weekend. We issued 11 driving while suspended tickets this year and none last year. We issued 2 negligent driving tickets this year compared to 3 in 2013. We issued 2 MIP tickets and one contributing alcohol to a minor ticket this year. We had none of those last year. There was one assault reported this year. There were none last year. The slow drag event in Ilwaco was absolutely no problem. Traffic in Long Beach started to clear out around 11:00 PM on Saturday night. Again, overall I am very pleased with how the weekend went. It should be noted that approx. 125 verbal warnings were issued as well.

I attended training on September 17th. The class was titled "The Ultimate Leader". It dealt with such topics as delegating leadership, developing the enthusiastic beginner, dealing with the disillusioned learner and recognizing and developing my own style of leadership.


On the 18th I, along with members of the department, attended a dinner put on by the Elks. The dinner was for area first responders. I was asked to give a short speech. It was a very nice evening.

Child Protection Services worker Josh Jewell gave a class to the department on September 19th. He talked about new response systems that CPS is going to implement in 2015.

On the 21st the department held a department picnic for officers and family members.

On September 27th Officer Casey Meling participated in a DEA prescription drug take back event. This event is held twice a year. Approx. 107 pounds of prescription drugs were turned in to be destroyed by the DEA.

I attended training on the 30th. The class was sponsored by the Washington Cities Insurance Authority and was a law enforcement liability update.

I want to thank you again for meeting with me regarding possibilities for Peninsula Arts Association in future Long Beach City tourism outreach programs. Your plans, especially the work you are doing with the Long Beach Package Travel program, sound perfectly geared to bring people to our area for specific purposes such as art shows!

PAA does a fair amount of marketing on its own and one thing we have found to be especially effective in our efforts to reach out to larger, art minded audiences is our ad in *Our Coast*. This well produced magazine reaches the larger cities and although the cost is high, the results have been significant. We advertise with a small color ad featuring PAA's year of events. Since doing this, we have experienced a high number of visitors to our events from cities such as Seattle, Portland and along the I-5 corridor. But most importantly, these visitors have come specifically for the art show.

Our Spring and Fall art shows and our Thanksgiving weekend Studio Tour have benefitted in attendance and sales from visitors who have come with a purpose. Most stay the weekend. Package tours featuring the active and vast art community located on the Long Beach Peninsula can further this interest, and we have found the people coming to our shows with this intent to be interested in exploring area in total, with the means to do so. I think your work towards bringing groups here with planned itineraries will enhance this resource pool of tourists.

Regarding the rental of the Depot Building...it has been a tremendous improvement for our shows. The natural light, high ceilings and proximity to our office are all wonderful. The outside of the building is perfection and the gardens are beautiful. I have a few suggestions for the inside: a fresh coat of paint, addition of picture hanging rails to lessen holes in walls, clearing of area above the bathroom and addition of counter height cupboards along the south facing bathroom wall (the counter on top of these cupboards could be used for media handouts, cold buffet or meeting materials by people renting the building). I realize the cost factor has to be considered, but the facility would benefit and rentals could increase with these changes.
