
We would first like to extend our gratitude for the use of The Depot facility. The building has been a great resource for us & the community that has utilized it.

ORDINANCE No. 787

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LONG BEACH, WASHINGTON ESTABLISHING A FEE STRUCTURE FOR THE PERIOD RENTAL OF THE DEPOT FOR PUBLIC USE AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, there is a need within the community for public meeting space, and

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach has meeting space available at the Depot, and

WHEREAS, the City of Long Beach desires to make meeting space available,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF LONG BEACH, WASHINGTON, as follows:

SECTION 1. RENTAL RATES

Daily rental for meetings of not-for-profit groups and organizations deemed to provide a public benefit:	\$10.00
Daily rental for meetings of for-profit groups and organizations:	\$25.00
Daily rental for use of the facility for purposes other than meetings:	\$50.00
Annual rental for meetings of not-for-profit groups and organizations deemed to provide a public benefit, up to 12 meetings per year:	\$25.00
Cleaning deposit required for meetings:	\$25.00
Cleaning deposit required for other uses:	\$50.00

These rates shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect unless changed by Resolution of the Long Beach City Council..

SECTION 2. USES

Use of the facility shall be limited to meetings and other functions that do not involve any retail sales, use of power tools, use of cooking facilities other than small appliances such as coffee makers, and/or activities that could damage the facility in any way.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five days from and after its passage approval and publication in the manner required by law.

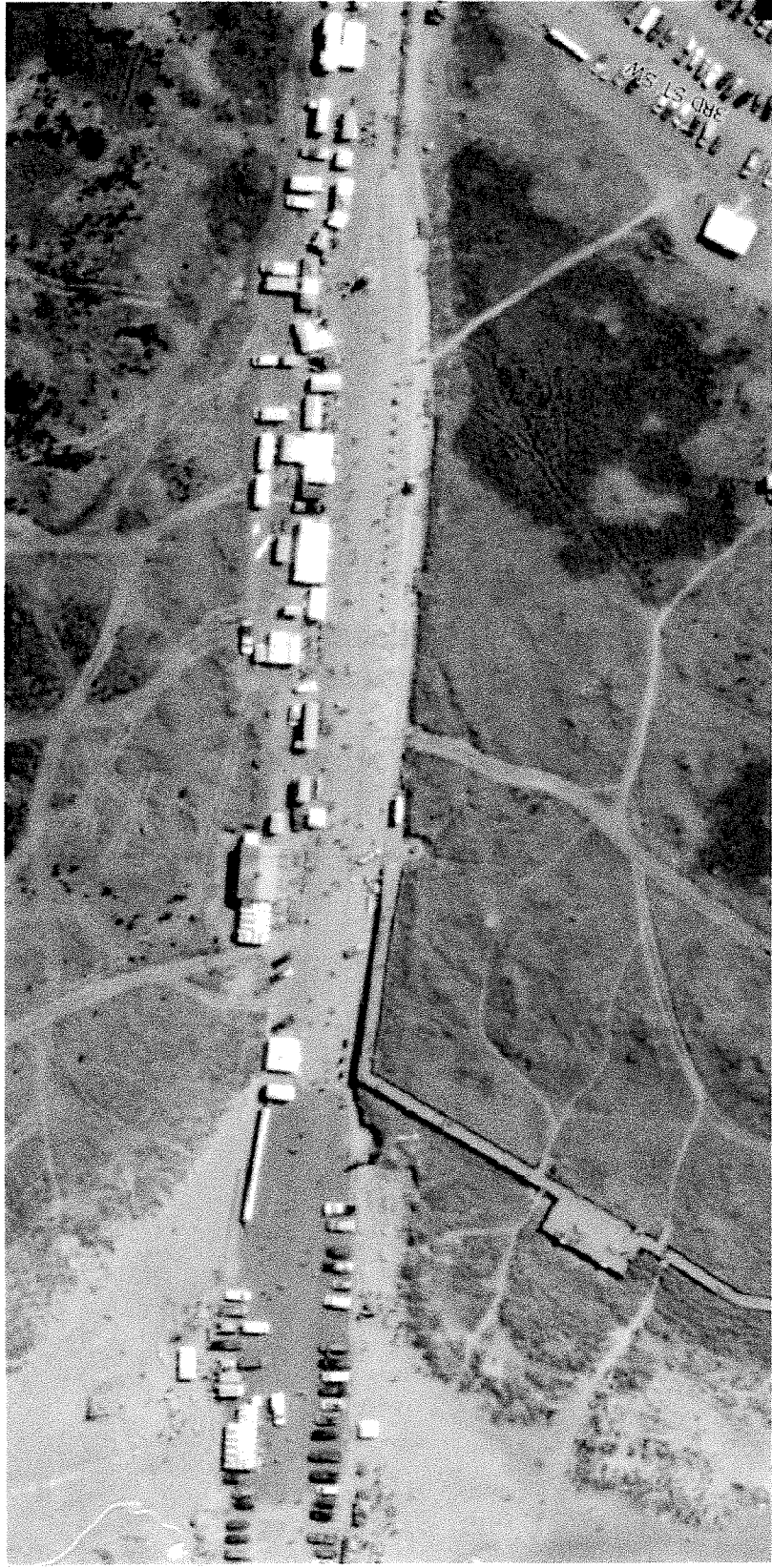
